

Max Coryell's Yellow Notepad

1. Downy Woodpecker (*Picoides pubescens*) heard at start of first outcropping
2. Largemouth Bass (*Micropterus salmoides*) saw in water near first preserve map
3. Sweetgum (*Liquidambar styraciflua*) spread over the preserve
4. American Beech (*Fagus grandifolia*) and Eastern Red Cedar (*Juniperus virginiana*) also spread over the preserve
5. American Sycamore (*Platanus occidentalis*) concentrated on the creek bank
6. Eastern Redbud (*Cercis canadensis*) also along creek bank
7. Red Salamander (*Pseudotriton ruber*) in leaf litter under the drip from the first outcropping
8. Spotted Dusky Salamander (*Desmognathus conanti*) and Mississippi Slimy Salamander (*Plethodon mississippi*) also under the drip
9. Green Anole (*Anolis carolinensis*) on the rock face of the first outcropping
10. Fire Pink (*Silene virginica*) on lower ridges along road
11. Blue Phlox (*Phlox divaricata*) in moist soil along creek
12. Skunk Rue (*Thalictrum revolutum*), Rue Anemone (*Thalictrum thalictroides*), Arrowleaf Butterweed (*Senecio triangulans*) and Early Saxifrage (*Saxifraga virginiana*) also in moist soil along creek
13. Red Trillium (*Trillium erectum*) sparse in glades
14. Lyre-Leaf Sage (*Salvia lyrata*) profuse along small ditches, particularly in the aiken area
15. Ground Ivy (*Glechoma hederacea*), Common Chickweed (*Stellaria media*), Purple Deadnettle (*Lamium purpureum*), Bedstraw (*Galium aparine*) and Azure Bluet (*Houstonia caerulea*) also profuse along small ditches, particularly near the aiken
16. Vinca-Periwinkle (*Vinca major*) exclusively along seep adjacent to aiken
17. Oakleaf Hydrangea (*Hydrangea quercifolia*) all over the preserve
18. Yellow Jessamine (*Gelsemium sempervirens*) at the picnic area
19. Wood Sorrel (*Oxalis montana*) in shade throughout woods
20. Pine Moss (*Lycopodium elavatum*) on banks and outcroppings
