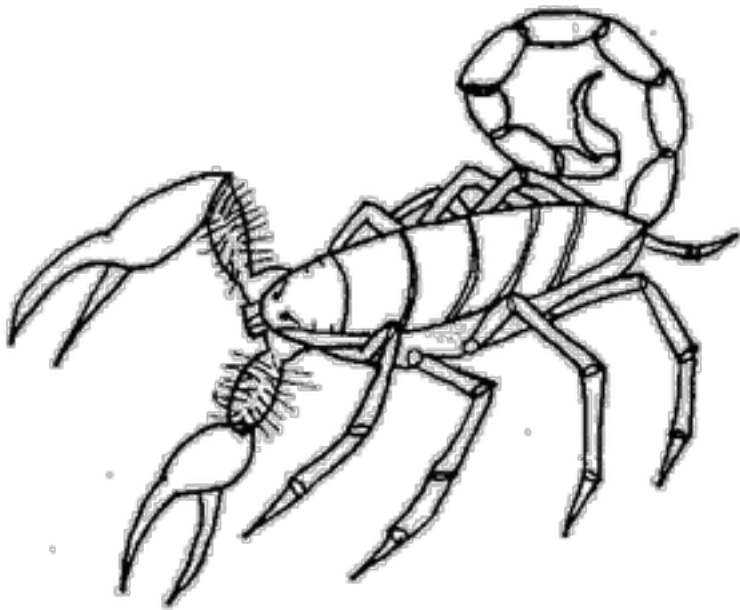


The Frog and the Scorpion

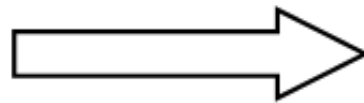

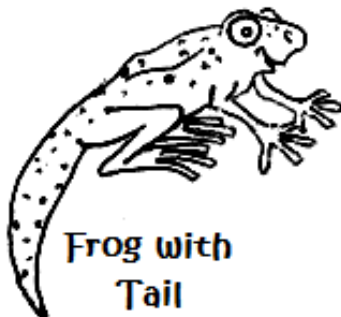

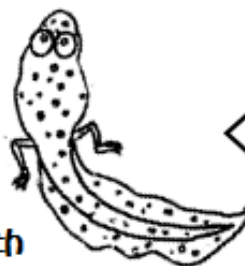
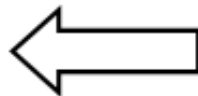

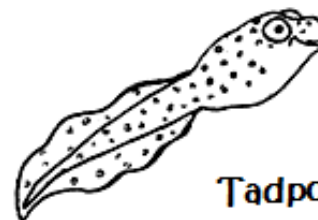
BULLFROG LIFE CYCLE
